08.30 Breakfast


- 09.30 Departure for the Abbey de Stavelot, upon arrival coffee will be served (www.abbaydestavelot.be).

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## **Museum Battle of the Ardennes**





The battle of the Bulge is the main theme evoked in the Museum.

The exhibition spans three floors and presents more than a 100 mannequins in uniform and 20 military vehicles.

Moreover, the Museum has a large collection of weapons and various equipment items, as well as photos and personal belongings. The Museum's dioramas depict various episodes of the battle.

In the winter of 1944-45 severe battles took place near the small town of La Roche-en-Ardenne. The plundered town was completely destroyed by the allies. Photographic reports of what has happened are also to be seen in the Museum.

### **Abbey Stavelot**







Between 1999 and 2002, the Abbey of Stavelot was completely renovated with the financial support of the Walloon region. The building of the community has got back its monastery. The new wing was built on the old foundations, the measurements of the fourth wing (destroyed after the French Revolution) were taken into consideration. The construction is made of glass and is stainless.

The building accommodates

#### three museums:

- the Museum of the Principality of Stavelot-Malmedy,
- the Museum of the Formula 1 Racing Circuit of Spa-Francorchamps,
- the Guillaume Apollinaire Museum.

Outside of the current Abbey, the archaeological remains of the Abbey Church venerated by the profane were recently restored.

## **Waterfalls of Coo**



The waterfalls of Coo are well-known and are definitely worth seeing. The site can be visited for free and serves as a starting point for many walkers.
The 15 m high waterfall is the highest and the most famous waterfall in Belgium.
The small waterfall exists since the 15th century, the bigger one was created in the 18th century

by the Prince-Abbot of Stavelot to protect from floods Petit-Coo located on the water.

At the foot of the waterfall of Coo tourists can choose from a variety of relaxing activities, such as miniature golf, go-kart racing and kayaking.

You can as well enjoy fantastic views over the Amblève Valley!



At the foot of the waterfalls there are also the Plopsa Coo park, with various attractions, and a big natural park that can be discovered during a 40 minutes train ride.

The entrance to the park is free of charge, however, in order to visit its attractions we suggest that you buy an all-in ticket.
